### Tungsten Fabric Kubernetes Networking

• Tungsten Fabric as an integrated CNI for StarlingX Kubernetes platform:

ARLINGX

- Deployable by StarlingX Ansible Playbook during initial bootstrap
- Containerized Service Deployment of TF control plane and data plane
  - Control plane deployment should be optional for multi-cluster deployments
  - Data plane deployment should support Kernel, DPDK, SRIOV and SmartNIC data paths
- Shared control plane for Distributed Cloud deployments:
  - Control deployed to central region (configdb, config, control, analyticsdb, analytics and webui)
  - Agents deployed on sub-clouds with vRouter data path

## **StarlingX TF Deployment Model**





### **Integration Investigation**

- Cluster Deployment Architecture
  - StarlingX supports 1 and 2 node control node deployment architectures which must support the clustering requirements of TF (quorum requirements 3, 5, 7, etc nodes)
- Network Interface Configuration
  - System Inventory and Configuration of StarlingX handles all infrastructure management of the host and network interfaces which would need to be coordinated with TF
  - TF assumes the role of managing the control and data network interfaces
- Data Path Integration
  - vRouter kernel data path requires a kernel module built for the StarlingX kernels (CentOS based)
  - vRouter DPDK data path requires access to huge pages and VFIO device binding
    - Standard setup for a containerized DPDK application
- Host Network Firewall
  - StarlingX OAM Network host firewall policies are currently based on Calico GlobalNetworkPolcy and HostEndpoint CRD resources
- Shared Control Plane for OpenStack
  - Rather than deploy a standalone instance of TF for the containerized OpenStack, it would be ideal to share the same control plane for both the Container and Virtualized Workloads
